

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
for
J. M. Huber Corporation Employee Benefit Plan

This is a summary of the annual report of the J. M. Huber Corporation Employee Benefit Plan, EIN 13-0860350, Plan No. 501, for period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Aetna Life Insurance Company, EyeMed, Magellan Healthcare, National Union Fire Ins. Co. of Pittsburgh, Pa, and Prudential Insurance Company of America to pay certain health, dental, vision, life insurance, temporary disability, long-term disability, employee assistance program, business travel accident, and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2017 were \$2,033,611.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2017, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$68,149 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$25,161.
